Once a full-time carer, Ginette soon found herself without a job when seizures brought on by epilepsy and mental health problems made it impossible for her to continue:

"Action Homeless have really been there for me over the last couple of years. I love the house I'm living in now...

My depression and anxiety means that sometimes I struggle to leave the house or communicate with people, so when I'm feeling really low it's nice to have my housemates nearby to help me. It really creates a sense of community within our home.

Action Homeless are always on the end of the phone, too, and they'll help me get back into work when my doctor says I'm ready to.

"There are so many people affected by homelessness and charities like Action Homeless do an incredible job of helping reduce the amount of homeless people in the area. They've helped to bring me out of my shell and regain my confidence."

100% of the money raised over the Christmas period will go towards helping people like Ginette.

By providing people with safe, stable and affordable homes, we can help them to regain their independence and lead happy and fulfilled lives.

Action Homeless believes that everyone has the right to a home but recognises that there is a lack of good quality affordable housing in Leicester. That is why our aim is to have created 100 new units of accommodation in the city by the end of this year. We are well on our way to achieving that target and thanks to your support are going into 2018 with funds to get started on our next property.
